Dolbey Systems Moves from Mentor to New Facility in Concord, OH

Concord, OH – Dolbey Systems, Inc. announces today that it has a new home in Concord Ohio. Since 1993, Dolbey had leased a 7500 square foot industrial condo space on Tyler Blvd in Mentor. The newly owned facility is a 26,000 square foot free standing building at 7280 Auburn Road.

Six months ago, the new building was a vacant industrial shell with no interior materials or windows. With the purchase of the building, a completely original layout was constructed from the ground up including installation of over 55 windows, office space, shipping/receiving, recreation room and warehouse.

Kris Wilson, President of Dolbey Systems states, “As our company has grown it was evident that we needed to invest in a larger property where we could continue to grow while also gaining a long term asset. Almost 10,000 square feet has been left open for expansion to our current office space so that as we move forward, we can take advantage of our current property rather than moving to another location. We are very enthusiastic about our new home and the expansion capabilities this larger facility provides.”

Dolbey Systems currently has 30 full time employees at its new location with a projection of 40 employees by the year 2005.
